

A LITTLE GOES A LONG WAY

Watch God take your everyday actions and transform them for his eternal purposes.

Contrary to how you may feel, every little thing you do can go a long way in God's hands. Partnering with God unlocks the eternal significance of the smallest act. Rachael shares:

- personal stories of how God values each deed,
- practical actions for lasting impact, and
- encouraging prayers that reveal how much your contributions matter.

BEING A LOVE OFFERING

As the host of The Love Offering podcast, over five seasons Rachael has explored how to live out the command to love God and love people. Through her own experience and through her conversations with 250+ guests, she has learned how to practically live out her faith—living faithfully and loving fully. She hopes to show women how to first accept God's love, then offer his love out of the overflow.

MOTHERHOOD: A LITTLE GOES A LONG WAY IN MOTHERHOOD

Rachael is the mother of two middle-school-aged children. When she was a stay-at-home mom, she knew in her heart that being a mom was important work but the monotony and mundane nature of the role didn't always feel significant. Now the time she wished away is the time she wishes back. She can see in hindsight how all the little moments of motherhood shaped her children. Rachael shares lessons gleaned from biblical mothers to influence how we view and function as mothers today.

MARRIAGE: A LITTLE GOES A LONG WAY IN MARRIAGE

Rachael has been married to her husband for seventeen years. She shares about how little actions done consistently over time can go a long way in your marriage. Rachael explores Jesus' interaction with Peter in John 21 when Jesus asks, "Do you truly love me? Do you really love me? Are you even my friend?" Her hope is that we can respond immediately with an emphatic yes! Not just a yes with our words but a yes with our actions as well. A little love in word and deed goes a long way.

DO NOT DESPISE SMALL BEGINNINGS

We want our lives to count, but we feel minuscule, like our ordinary everyday moments will never amount to anything. We take stock of the families we were born into, the towns we grew up in, and the positions we serve in, then determine they are of little value. If we aren't careful, we can start to believe that who we are, where we are, and what we are doing doesn't really matter. Using Zechariah 4:10, Rachael teaches about the Jewish remnant who had similar thoughts after they returned to Judah to rebuild the temple and their nation. Through the prophet, they learned that bigger and more beautiful isn't always better. The presence of God on the inside of the temple was what made it significant. Rachael hopes to encourage women to be faithful in the small things, begin where they are, do what they can, and leave the results up to God.

SIGNIFICANCE

Using Ephesians 2:10 as her anchor verse, Rachael wants women to know they are God's workmanship created to do good works. Knowing that we are made in God's image and thus share many of His characteristics provides a solid basis for our self-worth. Rachael explains how to move past feeling insignificant and inadequate and how to stop questioning the value of who we are and what we do. She wants attendees to believe that because of God, they have inherent significance and everything they do for him is meaningful.

YOU ARE MORE THAN WHAT YOU ACCOMPLISH

Rachael understands what it's like to be an achiever and perfectionist by nature. On days she accomplishes a lot, she feels great satisfaction, but on days she accomplishes very little, she is greatly disappointed. Using examples from the creation story in Genesis as well as from Jesus' baptism, Rachael explains that while there is value in what we do, we cannot gain our value from what we do.

MAKING AN IMPACT

During Jesus' time on earth, he demonstrated the importance of "a little." He valued, noticed, served, and rewarded little things. Nothing was too insignificant for the Savior of the world. So, why do we regularly consider bigger to be better? Rachael gives biblical accounts of how God sees and values every little thing we do. She helps women believe that when they partner with God, he can use even the most minute things to affect eternity in ways beyond what they can imagine. Together, we can accomplish great things in our everyday moments by offering all we are and all we have to God.
